Steve Gillette & Cindy Mangsen have been performing together for 20 years, bringing together their love of traditional music and their wealth of original songs. Accompanying themselves with guitar, concertina and banjo, their live performances are known for rich harmony, compelling songs and a good dose of humor.

Steve has been writing songs since the 1960's. His songs have been covered by Ian and Sylvia, John Denver, Garth Brooks, Linda Ronstadt, Tammy Wynette, and many others. But Steve's own versions are some of the best, with his warm baritone voice and his unique finger-picking guitar style. His recent solo album, *Texas and Tennessee*, was named one of the Top Ten Folk Albums of the Year by Tower Records.

Cindy is "one of the finest singers in American folk music" (*Come for to Sing*) and is known for her compelling interpretations of traditional ballads, as well as for her own writing and her wonderful ear for harmony. She has recorded several solo albums as well as collaborations with Steve Gillette, Priscilla Herdman, Anne Hills, and Michael Smith. Her recent solo album, *Cat Tales*, is devoted to "songs of the feline persuasion."
