Cosy Sheridan with TR Ritchie



Cosy Sheridan, with her partner and fellow songwriter and bassist **TR Ritchie**, gives one of the most entertaining and intelligent concert performances on the folk circuit.

The Albuquerque Journal refers to **Sheridan** (www.cosysheridan.com) as "A Buddhist monk in a twelve-step program trapped in the body of a singer-songwriter." Winner of both the Telluride Bluegrass Troubadour Contest and the Kerrville Folk Festival's NewFolk Songwriting Contest, she has played everywhere from Carnegie Hall to the Philadelphia Folk Festival. Along with several

traditional thought-provoking CDs including her latest *Eros*, Cosy has also written a one-woman-show (and accompanying CD) entitled *The Pomegranate Seed – An Exploration of Appetite, Body-Image and Myth in Modern Culture*. She recently composed a song-cycle for best-selling author Robert Fulghum's new book *Third Wish* – which has been at the top of the bestseller list in the Czech Republic since last year.

TR Ritchie (www.trritchie.com) learned his musical chops as a busker at the famed Pike Street Market of Seattle during the late '70's. Since then, TR's artful songwriting ability has been acknowledged by many songwriting showcases and competitions. In concert Ritchie is spontaneous, engaging and spirited. By turns witty, insightful and philosophical, the natural storyteller in Ritchie delivers a gem of a performance every time out with no bells or whistles. What you see is what you get: first-rate songs, written with a poet's love of language and a storyteller's turn of phrase, performed with unapologetic enthusiasm.
