Country, folk, jazz and French?!? All in one show in Anaheim tonight!

Albert & Gage with special guest **Dafni** and her band



Albert & Gage's visits to our series in 2005 and 2007 created whole roomfuls of new fans for this Texas duo's energetic, world-class music. Over the course of ten years and five duet albums, the duo have demonstrated that disparate backgrounds do not preclude musical soulmates from making beautiful music together. Gage is a journeyman musician who began touring at age 15. In the mid-70s and early 80s he led the popular midwestern country-swing Red Willow Band, and from there graduated to an eight-year tenure on piano with country star Roy Clark. This was followed by a stint as bandleader for Texas singer/ songwriter Jimmie Dale Gilmore. Christine's French grandmother lived in Paris and her mother was born in Switzerland, so perhaps it's inevitable that the occasional Edith Piaf song (with Chris on accordion) migrates into their sets of original material and carefully chosen covers. Working in the tradition of jazz classics like Billie Holiday and Nina Simone, **Dafni** has created a stellar Americana jazz style. Dafni grew up in Wisconsin, the daughter of Greek immigrants. She took to organ at an early age and throughout school played bass guitar, French horn, and piano. Currently Dafni continues to play with her band (tentatively featuring for our show Geoff Rakness on upright bass, Mark San Filippo on drums and Wil Forbis on lead guitar, banjo and mandolin) in support of her *Charlie's Lonely Sunday* album.
